**6 NIGHT & 7 DAYS**





# DAY 1: ARRIVAL AT GUWAHATI AIRPORT - TRANSFER TO SHILLONG

*Shillong, the first capital of Meghalaya, is located in pine-covered hills with a milder climate. Known as the Scotland of the East, it has waterfalls and reflects British architectural influences.*

- *Arrive at Guwahati and transfer to Shillong.*
- *En-route stop at Umium Lake viewpoint.*

**Overnight stay at Shillong.**



## DAY 2: SHILLONG TO CHERRAPUNJEE - SHILLONG

- *Breakfast at the hotel and drive to Cherrapunjee, one of the wettest places on Earth.*
- *Visit Seven Sisters Falls, Nohkalikai Falls, Mawsmai Cave, and eco-park.*
- *En route back to Shillong, visit Elephant Falls.*

***Overnight stay at Shillong.***



## DAY 3: SHILLONG - MAWLYNNONG / DAWKI - SHILLONG

- *Proceed to Mawlynnong, a clean and colorful village known for its Root Bridge, Sky Walk, and Natural Balancing Rock.*
- *Visit Dawki for its crystal-clear river water & Indo-Bangladesh Border.*
- *Evening free for leisure.*

*Overnight stay at Shillong.*



## DAY 4: SHILLONG - LAITLUM CANYONS - SHILLONG

- *After breakfast, proceed to Laitlum Canyons, offering stunning views of green rolling hills.*
- *Return to Shillong in the evening.*

## DAY 5: SHILLONG - MAWPHLANG / MAWSYNRAM - SHILLONG

- *Visit Mawsynram, the place with the highest recorded rainfall in the world.*
- *Explore Mawphlang Sacred Grove, one of the biggest Sacred Groves in Meghalaya.*
- *Visit the Khasi model village and later return to Shillong.*
- *Visit Elephanta Falls and Shillong Peak for breathtaking views.*

***Overnight stay at Shillong.***



## DAY 6: SHILLONG - LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- *Breakfast and transfer for local sightseeing, including Cathedral church, Wards Lake (closed on public holidays), and Don Bosco Museum (closed on public holidays).*

*Overnight stay at Shillong.*



## DAY 7: DROP AT GUWAHATI AIRPORT

- *Bid farewell to the tour with wonderful memories. Drop at Guwahati airport.*
