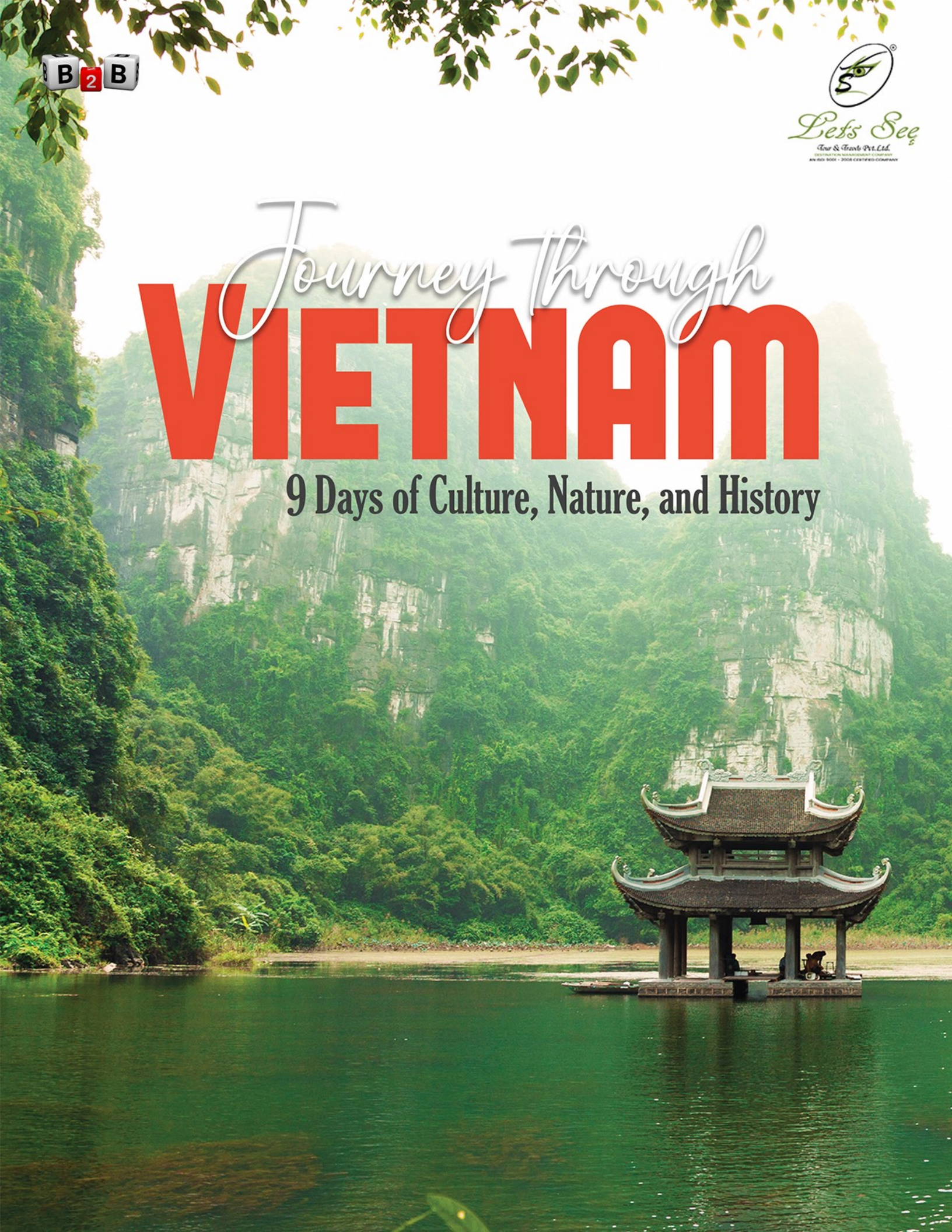

DAY 1: DEPARTURE KOLKATA TO HANOI:

Reporting at Kolkata international Airport at 18:00 hrs and Departure by indigo Airlines at 21:55 hrs and early morning (02:10 hrs) arrival at Hanoi.

Upon your arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, Hanoi, our dedicated guide will welcome you with a personalized sign bearing your name. Following a pleasant 50-minute to 1-hour journey, you will swiftly arrive at your hotel, where an early check-in has been thoughtfully arranged.

DAY2: HANOI - HALF-DAY CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

In the afternoon, immerse yourself in the enchanting city with a captivating half-day tour. Begin with a visit to the esteemed Ho Chi Minh Complex and Ba Dinh Square, revered as a significant pilgrimage site for many Vietnamese. Explore notable attractions such as the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (exterior view only), Ho Chi Minh's Stilt House, the Presidential Palace, and the Ho Chi Minh Museum, which transports you back to the humble beginnings of Ho Chi Minh's revolutionary journey.

Venture a short distance from the Ho Chi Minh Complex to discover the graceful 11th-century Buddhist One Pillar Pagoda. Continue exploring by visiting the historic Temple of Literature, renowned as Vietnam's first university, established in 1070 by the Ly Dynasty to honor Confucius, revered sages, and exceptional Vietnamese scholars.

Concluding the complex's visit, embark on a delightful walk through the famed Old Quarter, renowned for its ancient streets that depict traditional trades from bygone eras. Lose yourself in the captivating ambiance of this vibrant quarter, where echoes of the past intertwine with modern life.

Day 3: HANOI - HA LONG OVERNIGHT ON BOAT (B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart from Hanoi and drive for approximately 2.5 hours to reach Ha Long Bay. There will be a 20-minute stop along the way. Arrive at the jetty in Ha Long City around noon and complete the check-in process. Once onboard, you will be welcomed and served lunch as the boat cruises toward the bay. In the afternoon, you can visit attractions, engage in activities based on the boat's itinerary, or simply relax onboard. As the day comes to a close, the boat anchors for the night amidst the stunning karst formations. Enjoy dinner onboard.

Day 4: HA LONG – TRANSFER BACK HANOI – FLIGHT TO DA NANG (B/BR)

Experience the invigorating morning amidst Ha Long Bay as the sun gently ascends the horizon. Indulge in a delightful breakfast, or perhaps brunch on select boats, while leisurely cruising past the awe-inspiring rock formations. Eventually, return to port and disembark, followed by a transfer back to Hanoi. Anticipate arriving in Hanoi during the late afternoon. Enjoy your free time at your leisure before our driver escorts you to Noi Bai International Airport for your flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival at Da Nang Airport, our guide and driver will be waiting to greet you and transfer you to the hotel for check-in.

Day 5: DA NANG – CAM THANH VILLAGE – HOI AN CITY TOUR – DA NANG (B/L)

Transfer from Da Nang to Cam Thanh to begin your excursion. Board a local wooden basket boat in Cam Thanh water coconut village to experience the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen and their community. Cruise to the Cua Dai River, where thousands of water coconut trees once served as a habitat for the Vietnamese army during the war. Learn traditional fishing techniques from local fishermen using round or cast nets, and try paddling the unique Vietnamese bamboo basket boat. Explore the serene waterways flanked by coconut palms, a reminder of the war's history and the hardships endured by soldiers.

In the afternoon, transfer to Hoi An for a city tour. Hoi An, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, was a bustling maritime port from the 15th to 19th centuries. It showcases a captivating blend of Vietnamese and international cultures, influenced by China, Japan, Thailand, and the Philippines. Visit the iconic 400-year-old Covered Bridge, a remarkable example of Japanese architecture, and the Museum of Trade Ceramics housed in a beautiful Vietnamese-style wooden house dating back to 1858. Explore the Tan Ky House, a 200-year-old Chinese merchant residence, and Ong Temple, built in 1653 by Chinese settlers to honor Guan Yu, a revered ancient Chinese general symbolizing loyalty, bravery, and justice. Finally, immerse yourself in the lively local market filled with vibrant colors and bustling activity.

Day 6: DA NANG – BA NA HILL – GOLDEN BRIDGE – DA NANG (B/L)

In the morning, depart for Ba Na Hills or Chua Mount in Da Nang City. Take Nguyen Tat Thanh Street along the beautiful Red Beach. Ba Na Hills is a former French resort transformed into a famous amusement park in Vietnam due to its great location, landscape, and climate. Arrive at the Cable car station at the foot of Ba Na Mountain. Experience the longest non-stop cable car (5,042m) and highest non-stop cable car (1,292m), offering stunning views of Danang and the surrounding forests. Upon reaching Ba Na Hills, visit the Golden Bridge, an iconic structure connecting the cable car station to the main gardens. Admire the 150-meter-long walkway with its striking design featuring two giant hands supporting the bridge.

Explore other attractions such as Le Jardin d' Amour, old wineries, French Villas, and Ling Ung Pagoda with its 27m high Buddha statue. Head to the mountaintop to see the remains of the old French villas. Reach the Peak of Chua Mount at 1,487m for a panoramic view of Da Nang city amidst white clouds.

Continue the journey with a visit to Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and the ruined Opera House. Encounter wild monkeys and capture memorable photos. Return to the Cable car Station for the journey back to the foot of the Mountain and transfer back to Da Nang City.

Day 7: DA NANG – FLIGHT TO HO CHI MINH CITY – HALF-DAY CITY TOUR (B/L)

You have free time until your transfer to Da Nang Airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, our guide will welcome you and assist with your hotel transfer.

In the afternoon, join our half-day city tour. Start by visiting the renowned War Remnants Museum, showcasing a comprehensive collection of Vietnam War artifacts, including machinery, weapons, photographs, and documents. Marvel at the displays of military equipment and notable exhibits like the F5A fighter and UH-1 Huey helicopter.

Next, explore the century-old Reunification Palace, an architectural gem steeped in historical significance, witnessing key events in old Saigon and the growth of Ho Chi Minh City. Conclude the tour with a visit to Ben Thanh Market, a vibrant marketplace in District 1, where you can browse a wide array of goods. We'll provide transportation back to your hotel or drop-off at a central location of your choice.

Day 8: CU CHI TUNNELS – HO CHI MINH CITY TOUR (B/L)

In the morning, meet your guide at the hotel in Ho Chi Minh City and travel 75 km Northwest to the Cu Chi Tunnels. These tunnels were used by the Viet Cong during the French and American wars and comprised a vast underground network extending over 120 km. They housed various facilities like meeting rooms, kitchens, clinics, and schools, designed for guerrilla warfare. The tunnels were resilient against bombings and sieges.

In the afternoon, embark on a city tour. Visit the Saigon Notre-Dame Basilica, a stunning cathedral built by the French, showcasing neo-Roman architecture. Explore the serene atmosphere inside. Next, visit the Central Post Office, a historic landmark and the busiest post office in Vietnam. Designed by Gustave Eiffel, it features a neoclassical interior and displays painted maps of former Saigon. Conclude the tour in Cho Lon; the city's China Town, where you can admire the Jade Emperor Temple. Built in 1909 by the Cantonese community, it stands as a unique Taoist structure in Vietnam.

Day 9: FULL DAY MEKONG DELTA (MY THO) – DEPARTURE (B/L)

Embark on a car journey to the Mekong Delta, Vietnam's largest rice bowl. In My Tho City, board a motorboat to explore intricate canals, witness local life, and admire the scenic waterways. Step onto Thoi Son Island for traditional music and take a paddleboat to discover more canals. Visit homes where coconut candy and rice wine are made, then enjoy fresh honey tea and fruits at a bee farm. En route to My Tho, visit the ornate Vinh Trang Pagoda. Finally, your guide will pick you up at your hotel and drive you to Tan Son Nhat International Airport in an air-conditioned vehicle.
